How many words do you recognize?</p>	<p>Make a poster or a Venn diagram that depicts your culture and Francophone cultures: celebrities, food, holidays, street names, music, names of communities, traditions, etc. What similarities do you see between your culture and Francophone cultures?</p>	<p>Read a simple book or poem <i>en français</i> to a younger sibling or to a parent.  Did you recognize les <i>mots-amis</i>?</p>
<p>Make a collage of yourself and use it to orally describe yourself <i>en français</i>, giving as many details about yourself as possible.</p>	<p>Keep a simple journal <i>en français</i>. In this journal, you can record the date, the weather, and write one or two sentences on your own <i>en français</i> (emotions, activities you're doing on that day, etc.)</p>	<p>Make a crossword of French words: think of weather words, food words, clothing, sports, pastimes, animals, calendar words.</p>
<p>Record yourself speaking <i>en français</i> about your likes and dislikes using J'aime ❤️ ... and Je n'aime pas ... (food, sports, clothing, pastimes, seasons, weather, etc.) and share it with a sibling, a friend, a parent or your teacher upon your return to school.</p>	<p>Can you solve this riddle?</p> 	<p>Play a game of Scrabble <i>en français</i> with a sibling. Just make words that you know and try to use them in a complete sentence. For example: froid / Il fait froid.  You can find a Scrabble board on the back of this sheet.</p>
